(Pope St. John Paul II used to go once a week!) While Reconciliation is offered every Saturday afternoon before the Vigil Mass or can be arranged any time by appointment, during Advent and Lent the parish offers a beautiful Penance Service that provides an opportunity to go, with a variety of priests available to hear confessions. This is one of the best ways during Advent to prepare for celebrating Christmas! St. Mary's Church will have its **Advent Penance Service this Sunday afternoon at 2:30 P.M.**

Meet St. Juan Diego

- My Feast Day: December 9
- I am the patron saint of Indigenous people
- I was raised an Aztec pagan, but was converted to Catholicism when Franciscan missionaries came to Mexico.
- On December 9, 1531, on my way to Mass for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception I was stopped by the Blessed Virgin Mary and asked to make a request to the local bishop for a chapel in her honor there on Tepeyac Hill, site of a former pagan temple.
- To make the bishop believe, Mary sent me to pick flowers on the hillside to carry in my tilma for the bishop.
- When I presented this gift, a miraculous image of Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared and remained on my tilma.
- I was canonized a saint in 2002.
