LENT BEGINS TOMORROW WITH ASH WEDNESDAY (FEBRUARY 18th)

There will be an all school / parish Mass at 9:00 A.M. with the imposition of ashes.

FOR THE OBSERVANCE OF A HOLY LENT

Lent is the Holy Season to prepare us for Easter and ultimately for heaven. This is an ideal time to draw closer to Our Lord through prayer and the Sacraments, to strive to be more selfless to others through loving service, and to reorient ourselves to the proper use and appreciation of God's gifts in Creation by giving up some good things to be more disposed to receive that which is better - especially God Himself.

The following are instructions that Catholics are called upon to observe during Lent in communal offering to the Lord:

Everyone 14 or older should abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays in Lent.

Everyone between 18 and 59 should fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday: only one full meatless meal; "other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but altogether they should not equal another full meal."

Prudence is always to be observed with allowances for those who have circumstances that would jeopardize their health by fasting.

Meet St. Bernadette Soubirous

- My Feast Day: February 18
- I am the patron saint of the sick, the poor, shepherds, those ridiculed for the faith, and Lourdes.
- I came from a very poor family in Lourdes, France.
- When I was 14, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to me in a cave while I was gathering firewood.
- The Virgin was wearing a white robe with a blue sash, with yellow roses on her feet and a large rosary on her arm and called herself the Immaculate Conception.
- I saw 18 apparitions of Mary between February 11 and July 16, 1858.
- Mary instructed me to dig in the ground and miraculous spring appeared, which still provides God's healing to millions today.
- Mary also instructed that a chapel be built, which remains a popular pilgrimage site today.
