FROM THE PRINCIPAL...

"I've never had a male teacher before!" That is what one student said about me teaching 7-8 Grade Religion that had their whole school experience at St. Mary's with all female teachers. I know for certain that our teachers would do a better job than I could for most of them, so its not a question of competence. However, the presence of male adults in our student's lives is irreplaceable. Though our culture sometimes misses or minimizes this, the *complimentarity* of men and women is a great gift of God in Creation. It shows us that not only do we need each other to thrive, there are unique gifts that men and women exclusively possess that are meant for the good of the other, to bring out the best in the other.

I especially want to challenge men. We need to be inspired by men who sacrificially demonstrate strength through loving service- laying down their lives for their families, for the Church, for their communities and for all that is Good. When our young students see the heroic example of men demonstrating sacrificial love, they see what the best movies and books describe before their eyes! They also see a reflection of the love of Christ Who laid down His life for love of His Bride, the Church. In this sense, we all benefit from the witness of "male teachers."
